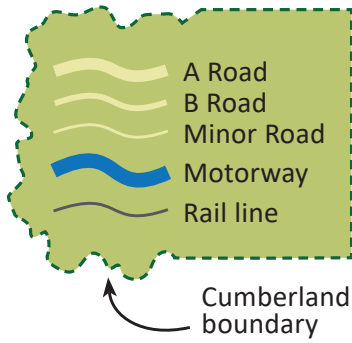

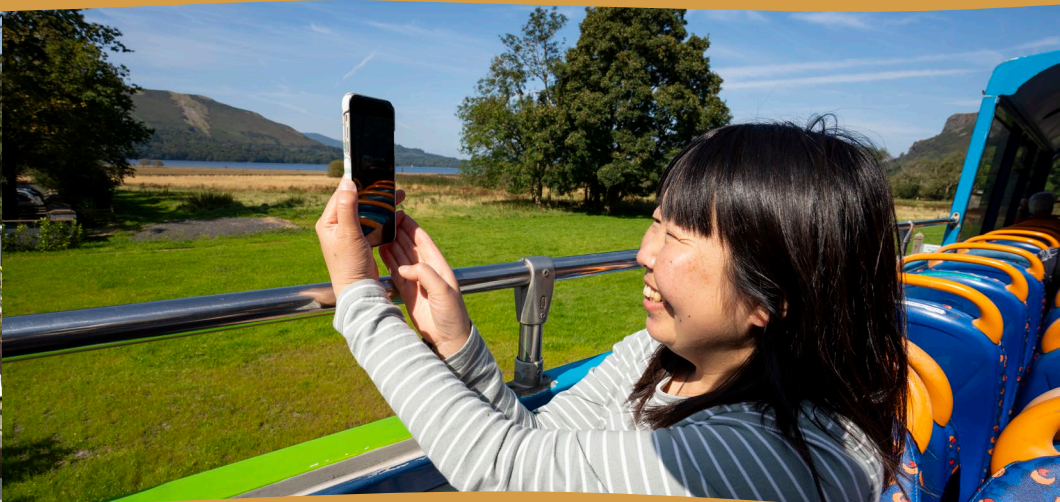

Start the day with a sunrise hike

There are some stunning hikes around Keswick. For something a little quieter, but no less scenic, try **1** Walla Crag: this well signposted Wainwright is a real hidden gem offering stunning views across Derwentwater. Start in Keswick, or take the incredibly scenic 78 bus to Great Wood for a shorter route.

Time for brunch

After all that hiking, you're probably feeling hungry, so it's time to head into Keswick for brunch! Lake Road Brunch is known for its photogenic (and equally delicious) pancakes; they also do all day brunch, cocktails, and excellent coffee.

Alternatively, head to the Lingholm Estate - their walled garden is said to have inspired Mr McGregor's garden in Beatrix Potter's Peter Rabbit. Here, you'll find the Lingholm Kitchen: a glass fronted cafe with views across the garden, serving up fresh, local dishes from breakfast to afternoon tea.

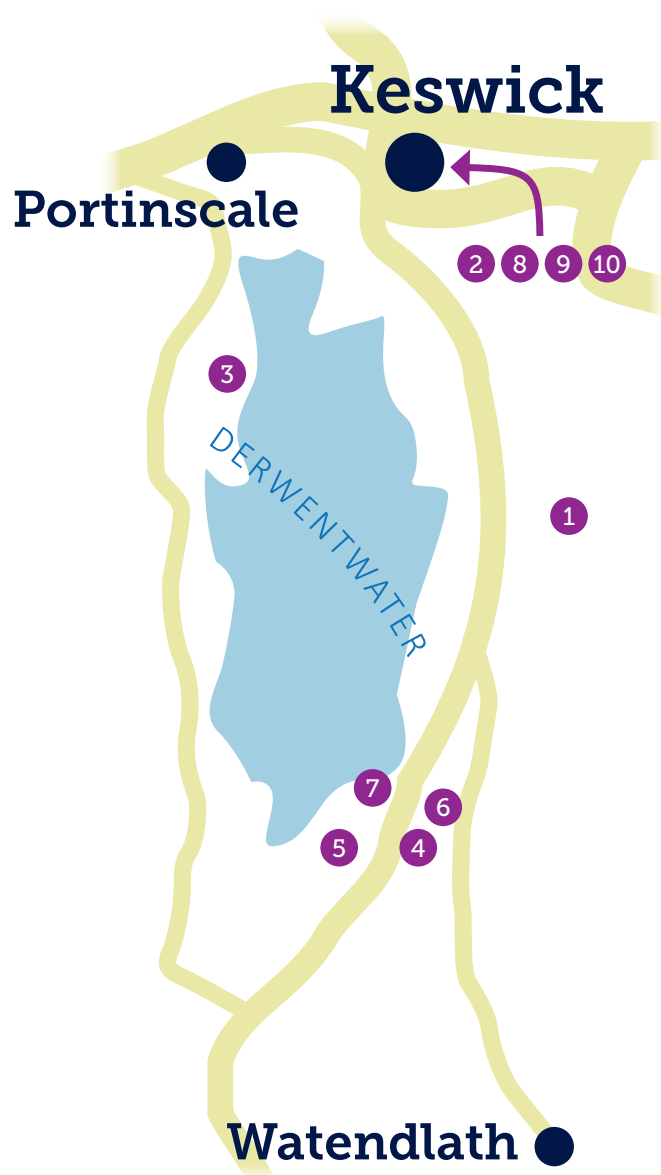

Cross the road to walk along the boardwalks

Just across the road from Lodore Falls, you'll find a boardwalked walking trail **5**. With Lakeland mountains on one side and Derwentwater on the other, it's a scenic place for a stroll. Alternatively, head up to Surprise View **6** on foot: it's a short walk from the hotel, or the nearby National Trust Kettlewell Car Park **7**.



TOP TIP: Why not arrive by boat? The Keswick Launch service docks at Lodore Jetty - just opposite Lodore Falls Hotel & Spa.
