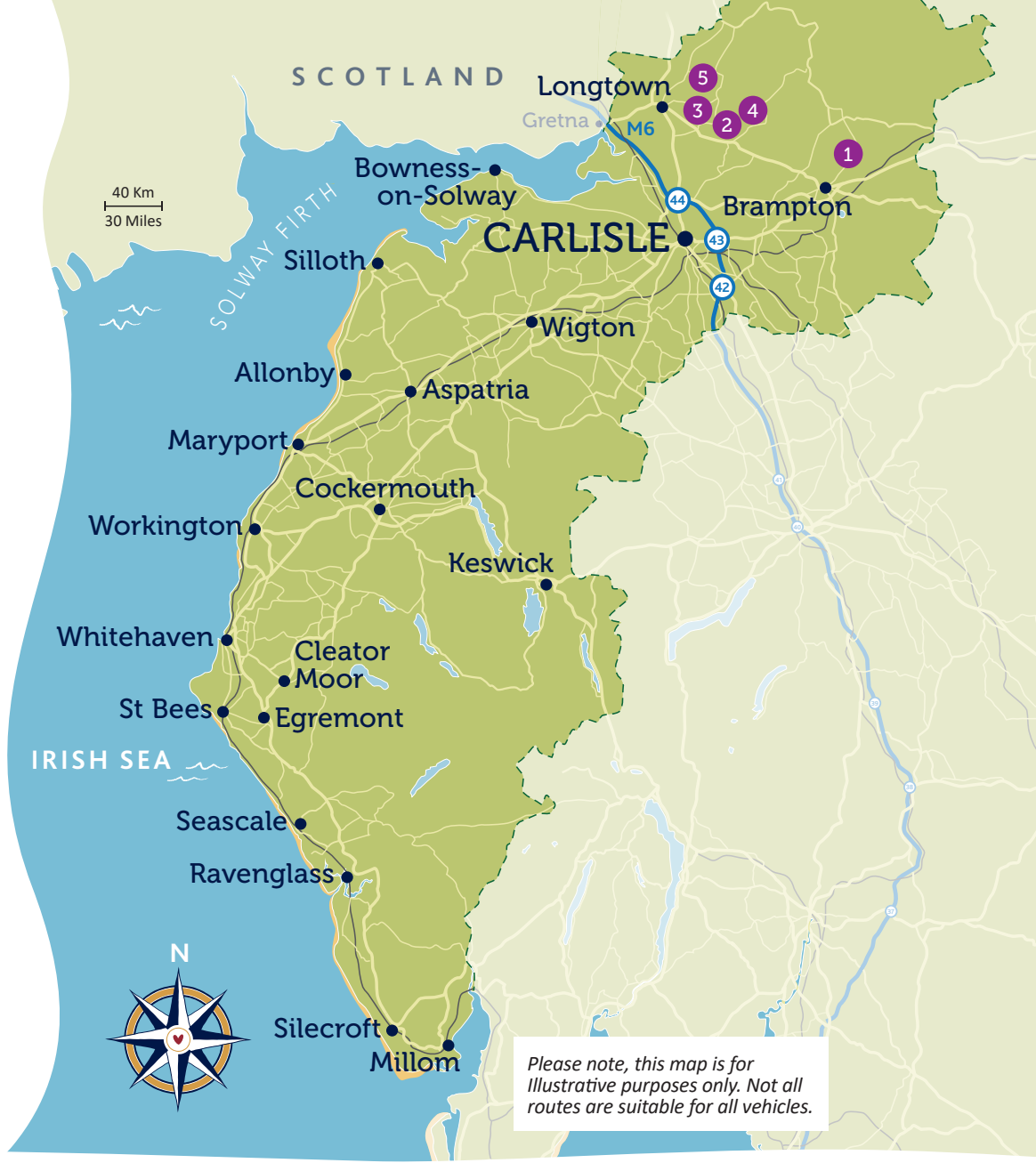

Begin your day with a trip to this striking Augustinian priory: managed by English Heritage, it features beautifully preserved cloisters and makes for an impressive sight in person and on camera!

DID YOU KNOW? Having endured numerous raids from the Scottish (including William Wallace and Robert the Bruce) Lanercost was once the seat of English royalty when Edward I stayed there for several months.

2 Kirklington Hall Carlisle CA6 6BB

With a colourful past - it was once a nightclub and casino, playing host to notorious gangsters like the Kray twins - the beautiful Kirklington Hall fell into ruin in the 1970s. Today, its grounds and gardens are an insta-worthy place to explore, before refuelling at the charming cafe. There's accommodation by way of cosy cottages, and it's also a wedding venue.
